

# 【Mandatory for All Students!】

## English Language Proficiency Test (Linguaskill Test 4 Skills)

To help you assess your English proficiency across all four skills – listening, reading, speaking, and writing – the university provides the English Language Proficiency Test (Linguaskill Test 4 Skills) during the first and third years. It is mandatory for all students to participate.

- Date and Time: Friday, September 30, 2024, at 1:30 p.m. (Room entry begins at 1:00 p.m.)
  - Examination Room: Lecture Room E21, 2nd floor, Wing-E, General Education Building
  - Duration of Examination: Approximately 3 hours and a half (including instructions and breaks)
  - Items to Bring:
    - a. Notification of student ID number (distributed during orientation)
    - b. Passport or Residence Card
    - c. Laptop \*Ensure your laptop has a fully charged battery and bring a recharging cord.
    - d. Notification of Okadai ID and Password (distributed during orientation)
- \* Please ensure that **your laptop has Google Chrome installed beforehand** (refer to the reverse side).

### ➤ What is Linguaskill?

Linguaskill is an online English proficiency test (4 skills) developed by Cambridge University's English Language Testing Institute that enables you to efficiently assess your English language proficiency.

#### <Key Points>

- CEFR levels are provided for each skill.
- Listening and reading employ adaptive methods, featuring distinct questions for each examinee.




(Reference) Installing Google Chrome on a Windows PC

- A) Search for "chrome download" in the browser you typically use.
- B) Go to Google's support site and click the "Download Chrome" button.



There may be differences in the descriptions, but as long as you have access to the Google support site, there should be no problem.

- C) Double-click the downloaded file and then click "Open". Please note that the file might not be on the desktop but could be in the "Downloads" folder or elsewhere.
- D) When the message "Do you want to allow this app to make changes to your device?" appears, click "Yes".
